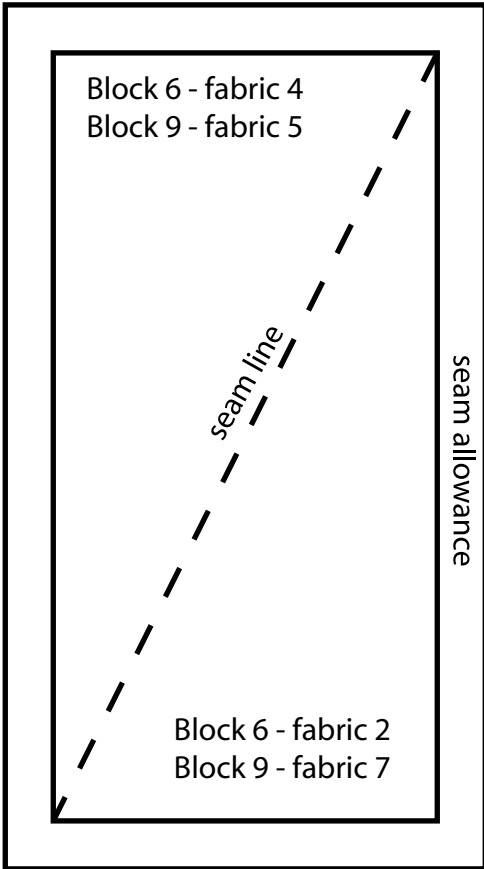
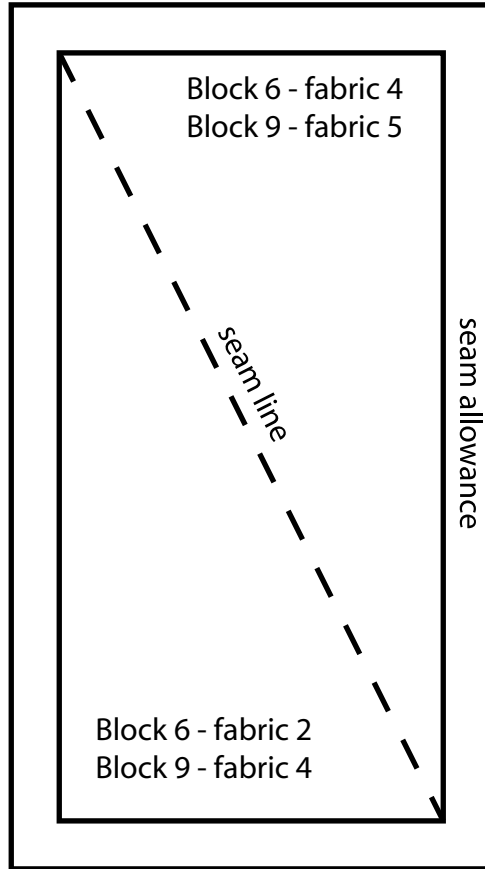


Blocks 6 & 9 - Need two pages (4 sets) of paper piecing patterns for each block. You may photocopy patterns or trace onto your desired paper.

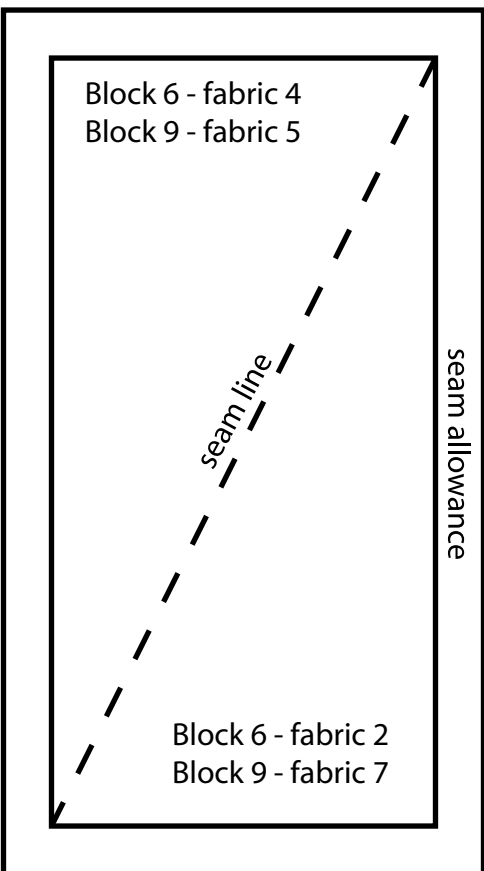
Two Part Rectangles - Paper Piecing Method



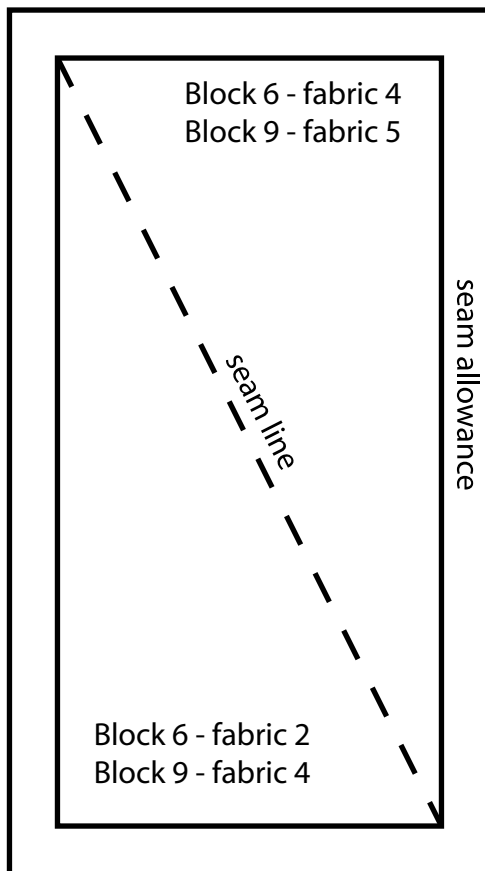

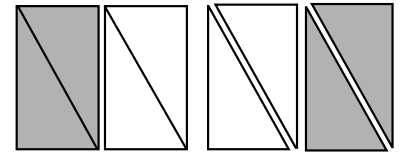

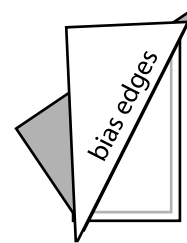

Cutting: Place rectangles right sides up. Cut diagonally from one top corner to the opposite bottom corner (look carefully at the diagrams below - how the rectangles are cut determines the background placement).

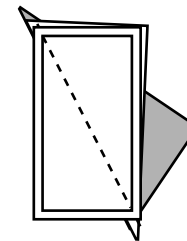
Cut fabric right side up



Cut fabric right side up



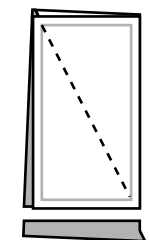
Place triangles right sides together and align bias edges on the back side of the paper pattern.



Turn paper over and stitch on the dotted line of the printed side of the pattern.



Press open.



Flip over and trim on the outside rectangle. Remove paper.
